Original duly Notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS); and if applicable, Original duly signed and Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative, or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder;
- G. Original Financial Bid Form (Request for Quotation Form);

- H. Valid Certificate of Product Registry from Fertilizer and Pesticides Authority (FPA) or Food Drug Administration (FDA);
- I. Certificate issued by the manufacturer that the bidder is an authorized distributor or reseller of the product;

- K. Current NFA-Operations Coordination Department/ Technical and Services Division (NFA-OCD/TSD) Certificate that the product being offered with given active ingredient passed the Technical Services Department (TSD) test and evaluation and is recommended for use in NFA Operations;
- L. Brochure and Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS).

A complete set of bidding documents may be acquired by interested offerors starting July 19, 2025 to August 7, 2025 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, during Monday to Friday except for holidays and on August 8, 2025 up to 9:00AM only, from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of One Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,000.00) bidding fee.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and NFA Website, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their offers.

The Procuring Entity shall allow the offeror to present its proof of payment for the fees in person or through electronic means.

The NFA Region VII Procurement Committee will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference** on **July 28, 2025** at 2:00 PM at 2nd Floor, National Food Authority Building, Governor Mariano Cuenco Avenue, Banilad, Cebu City which shall be opened to prospective offerors.

All quotation forms and required documents shall be submitted to the RPC Secretariat through manual submission at 2nd Floor NFA Building, Governor Mariano Cuenco Avenue, Banilad, Cebu City on or before 9:30 AM of August 08, 2025. Late bids shall not be accepted.

Opening of Quotations shall be on August 08, 2025 at 10:00 AM at the 2nd Floor National Food Authority Building, Governor Mariano Cuenco Avenue, Banilad, Cebu City.
